

## Creating a Class

Grouping students together in Classes is an efficient way to distribute Assignments. It's very easy to create a class in eMediaVA. Here's how -

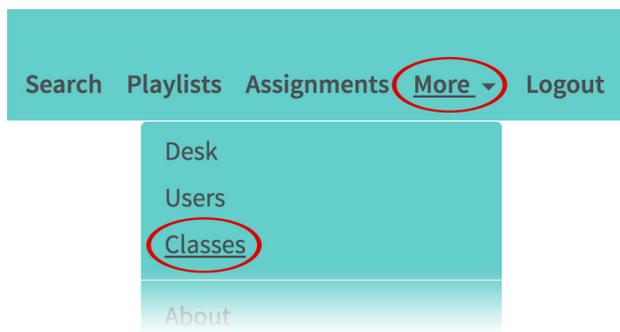
### STEP ONE

Begin by pointing your browser to <https://emediava.org>.

Go ahead and log in. *Note: You must log in to see your classes.*

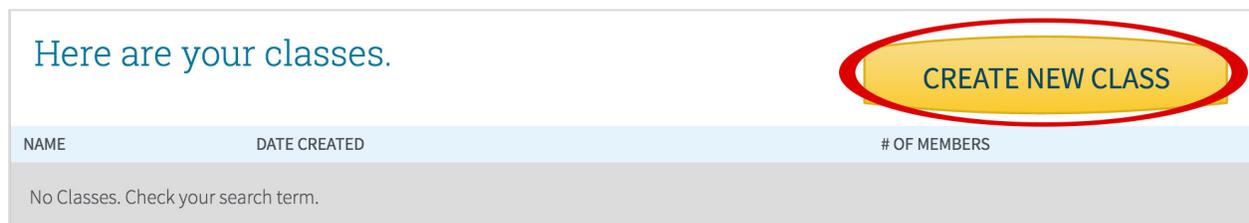
### STEP TWO

Click on **More** → **Classes** in the main navigation menu. Your classes are always accessible via this link.



### STEP THREE

Since we've never created a class before, this page looks rather bare. Let's remedy that. Click the **Create New Class** button.



**STEP FOUR**

**1. Give your class a name**

*This can be anything just so long as you and your students will recognize it.*

**2. Add students to your class.**

*Select as many students as you'd like from the list of names. This list is limited to students currently enrolled in your school.*

*If you're looking for a particular individual, use the **Search for a name** field.*

*Matching names and grade levels appear in the results box.*

Each name is highlighted once selected. (Click the name again to deselect it.) Highlighted names are included in the class.

Select as many students as you'd like from the list below. You can also search for individuals. All of your choices appear in the confirmation box to the right.

**STEP FIVE**

Confirm your selections. If everything appears to be in order, click **Create Class**.
